


Unprecedented Settlement Agreement

- Jan 2017 FAA and City of Santa Monica announce Settlement Agreement
 - Runway length reduction 4,973 ft. to 3,500 ft.
 - Requires airport to remain open through 2028
 - City has the <u>OPTION</u> to Close in 2029
- Lawsuits Pending
 - NBAA argues that FAA did not comply with mandatory statutory requirements
- Financial Mismanagement
 - Part 16 complaint pending
 - Over \$100,000 in park design Fees being returned
- Noise Monitor Locations ANCA Violation






