



*How to avoid delays over WHITE*

*Utilizing the Off Shore Route  
aka the AZEZU route*

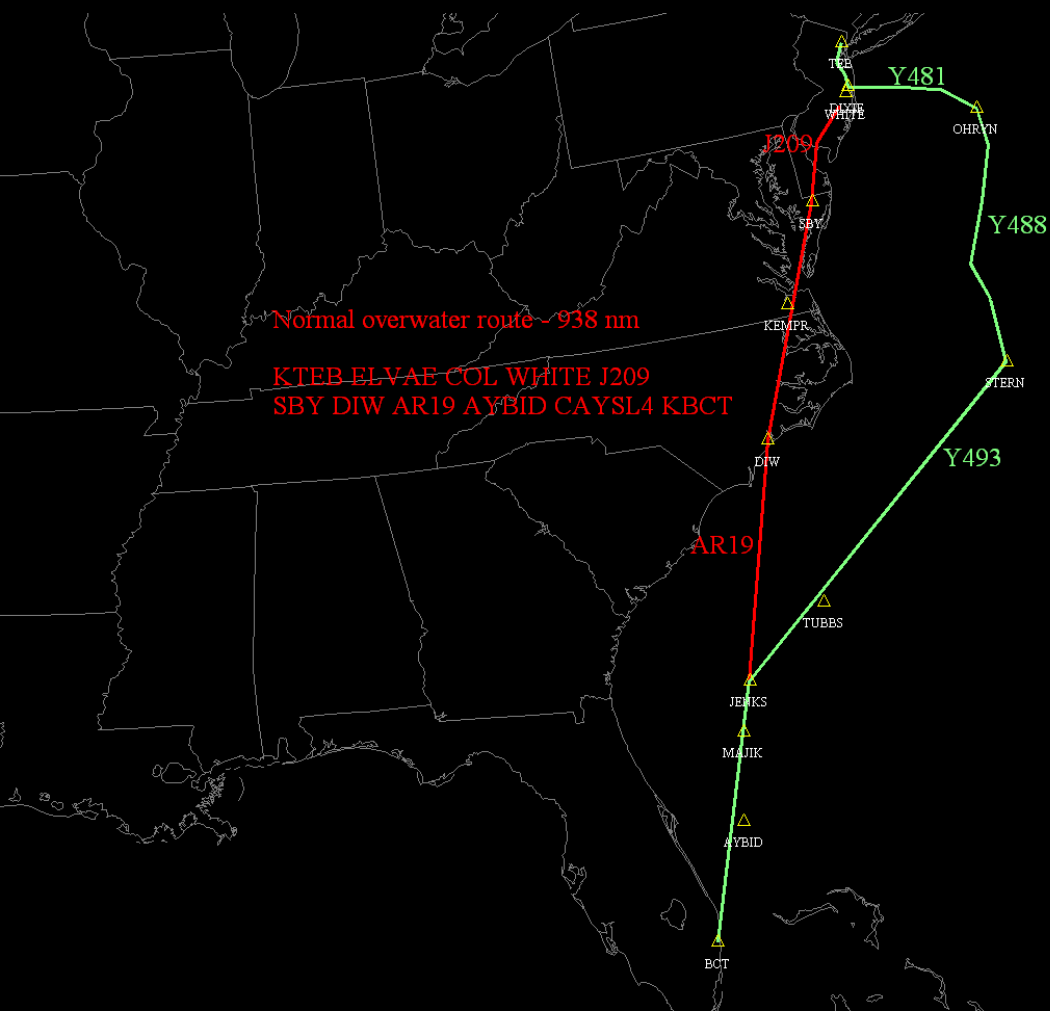
*WHITE is used by EWR, LGA, and HPN as well as TEB for traffic heading down the east coast, resulting in heavy demand and inevitable delays during peak times.*

*For flights destined to the Florida terminals, “AZEZU” is an option*

*Back in the late 90's, 2 radar sites along the coast were upgraded.*

*ATC personnel noticed that we could see far out over the ocean beyond airspace that was always blocked by the military.*

*Routes were designed to make use of this.*

West coast Florida traffic should file via LANNA (which usually has less volume than WHITE), but AZEZU is an available option

# *Why is it called the AZEZU route when AZEZU isn't even on the route?*

- Good question
- AZEZU used to be on the route when it was created about 20 years ago. Subsequent airspace and route structure changes occurred, and AZEZU is now only on the route for arrivals to the PHL area.
- We did discuss a name change, but the decision was made to keep the name because that's what everyone called it anyway

# *When is this option available?*



- Two radar sites are used by ATC on these routes – Fort Fisher (QGV - NC) and Oceana (QVR – Virginia Beach).
- Both sites must be operational unless aircraft is ADS-B equipped.
- If ADS-B equipped, the route is only available southbound if one or both radar sites are out
- Check NOTAMs before filing

# *Will ATC assign these routes?*



No, because ATC is not aware of the equipment on your aircraft (life rafts, etc).

Note – HF communication ability is not required

If you are filed via WHITE and believe (or are advised by the tower) that AZEZU may be a better option, you can request a change to the AZEZU route to the tower. The tower will advise ZNY, and we will make the route amendment
