Operators are advised that TEB RNAV (GPS) X RWY 06 is a frequently utilized approach at TEB. It is used to mitigate conflicting procedures in N90 airspace. Operators landing TEB should be prepared to accept this approach and be aware that alternatives are limited or may not be available.
