TETERBORO AIRPORT PILOT'S DEICING RESPONSIBILITIES 2023-2024

Pilots:

- 1. Obtain their IFR clearances from TEBT Clearance Delivery as soon as available.
- 2. Contact their FBO Deicing Boss/Ramp Manager to be listed for deicing.
- 3. Inform Deicing Boss/Ramp Manager of any restrictions issued by TEBT Clearance Delivery. If an Expect Departure Clearance Time (EDCT) is issued, the Pilot will inform the Deicing Boss/Ramp Manager of this departure restriction. The Deicing Boss/Ramp Manager shall make every effort to comply with this restriction by adjusting the Deicing lineup so that the aircraft can depart at the issued time. EDCT is a wheels-up time.
- 4. Ensure that prior to deicing:
 - a) Pilot has obtained their IFR clearance
 - b) All crew, passengers and baggage are on board
 - c) Aircraft is fueled
 - d) Except for de-icing, the A/C is ready to taxi
- 5. The Deicing Boss/Ramp Manager, will advise/signal the Pilot after deicing is complete.
- 6. After deicing is complete, Pilots will contact TEBT Ground Control when ready to taxi.

NOTE: After receiving their clearance from TEBT Clearance Delivery, Pilots are requested <u>not</u> to contact TEBT until after deicing is complete and ready to taxi. However, updates on field conditions will be available through the ATIS and or Clearance Delivery.

NOTE: When an immediate stop occurs during a single Runway operation, like a report of nil braking action, the impact on the field is substantial. With aircraft ready to depart, those in taxi status and those being deiced, are now all stopped; expect a return to the ramp for the appropriate time to be re-deiced.

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
