Mission

Corporate Angel Network (CAN) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that helps cancer patients access the best treatment available by arranging free travel on corporate aircraft.

Program:

- Founded in 1981
- Utilizes pressurized aircraft flown with two pilots
- 150+ patient flights completed every month
- 69,000+ completed flights since inception
- 500+ partners, including nearly half of the Fortune 100

Patient Participation



All CAN patients are ambulatory and able to travel without medical assistance.

Patients:

- All ages welcome
 - One or two caregivers allowed, space permitting
- Trips provided to patients from all financial backgrounds

Requirements:

- Cancer patient, or bone marrow/stem cell donor or recipient
- Appointment at a recognized cancer treatment center (confirmed by CAN team)
- Must be able to walk unassisted up aircraft stairs
- Does not require medical assistance while flying (and does not travel with IV/oxygen/etc.)
 - CAN confirms patient status directly with the medical team

Guidelines:

- All patients must dress in business casual attire
- Participating companies are to remain confidential
- No photos/videos permitted

Partnering with CAN

It is critical that CAN increases the amount of flight lift to assist more patients in need.

Flight Matching:

- Both live and empty legs are utilized
- CAN flight matches can be found by:
 - Automatic schedule sharing via flight sharing software (PFM, FOS, BART, CAMP, Tripplanning.biz)
 - Sending schedule by email
 - Reviewing seats needed on a weekly basis as provided by the CAN team
- If CAN calls for a flight match, there is no obligation – we understand that not all flights will be available
- Cancelled flights
 - We understand that business plans change. If a CAN flight must be cancelled, we will find an alternative flight for the patient.

Tax Incentives:

- Upon request, CAN will provide a letter noting the flight details and charitable contribution. We advise all partners to work with their tax advisor to receive guidance on tax implications.
