Subject: AREA OF REPORTS OF TERMINAL COLLISION AVOIDANCE SYSTEM (TCAS) RESOLUTION
ADVISORIES (RA's) AND TRAFFIC CONGESTION

Cancellation: 01/29/2027 1200 (UTC)

The purpose of this letter is to inform all users of Teterboro Airport (TEB) of areas where the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) control tower recognizes an increase in reported RA's:

1. The close proximity of all North-East Corridor/ Northern NJ Visual Flight Rules (VFR) traffic creates a circumstance where TEB arrivals descending on published Instrument Flight Rules (IFR) approaches for runway 19 experience RA's associated with VFR traffic transitioning east to west, or west to east, north of TEB's Class D airspace. VFR traffic climbing into the final for runway 19, along with TEB traffic descending for approach may compromise tower controller's ability to provide timely traffic advisories.
