

Operational Actions – Signature West Ramp

- ARFF contacted at 0521 for the report of an overturned fuel truck
 - *Rescue 1 & 2 responded
 - *Arrival found an overturned fuel truck with an active fuel tank leak
 - *Approximately 200-300 gallons of Jet-A leaked
- Immediate precautionary actions taken for fire protection
 - *HRET deployed for protective measures on Rescue 2 (Handlines)
 - *Mutual Aid requested for water supply at the direction of the Deputy Chief
 - *Overpacking capturing fuel leak from 6K tank; approximately 5K remained
- Coordination with TEB/99, PAPD Sergeant and Mutual Aid Chiefs
 - *Request for Bergen County HAZAMT via HHFD Chief

Locations Substantially Complete


- Locations 1 west, east, and east tributary, 3, 10, 5 North and South

- Nightly single runway closures will begin upon completion of daytime stages
- Weekend closures resumes earliest June 19 in Location 7 and Ditch D-F
- Full Airport Closures to be scheduled to work in Location 12
