Existing Program: Good Neighbor Awards

- Criteria: **No** noise level violations and **no** Quiet Hours flights (11pm-6am)
- Most prior award winners have relatively few annual flights (approx. 100)

Proposed Program Updates

- Goal
 - Add new awards that expand to all operators including those with the most flights
 - Encourage better performance and increase participation
- Approach
 - Maintain all elements of existing Quiet Flying Program
 - Continue the Good Neighbor Award and Honorable Mention Award
 - Create expanded awards opportunities
 - Add a dashboard scoring system

Potential New Scoring Elements

- Noise Level Violations (part of the existing program)
- Quiet Hours Flights (part of existing program)
 - Add the ability to improve scores when flying at night:
 - Use preferential runways when flying at night
 - Use the Runway 19 Offset Approach at night
 - Bonus for operators with no Quiet Hours flights
- Fleet Mix
 - Score based on operator's fleet mix operating at TEB
 - Bonus for Stage 5 Plus aircraft
- Engagement
 - Multiple categories - shown on next slide

Potential Engagement Categories

- Meeting participation
 - Participate in FQP Focus Group annual virtual briefings
 - Participate in TUG Meetings
- Pilot training/educational materials on noise abatement and Fly Quiet
- Provide information/documentation on fleet noise reductions
 - Pilot operating techniques, NADP training, etc.
- Provide documentation on sustainability practices
 - NBAA Program, local efforts, offsets, etc.
- Log-in to FQP Dashboard Reporting site once per quarter

Proposed Awards Tiers

- Alignment with existing awards
 - Good Neighbor Award – highest tier of points
 - Honorable Mention Award – second tier of points
 - N/A – operators falling below the points threshold
- Scoring system still under development
 - Consistency with existing awards
 - Weighting of score categories (total 100 points)
 - We want to ensure it's not too hard (or easy) to earn award

Upcoming Project Schedule

- September TUG meeting – Present draft scoring for comments and input
- October - December – Develop draft dashboard and scoring metrics
- January 2026 – Use full year of 2025 data to compute draft scores
 - A “beta test” to see how the awards play out, then see if any changes are needed to the scoring or thresholds
 - Share progress with TUG and operators to gather additional feedback
