

**A Summary of the Teterboro Airport Manager’s Meeting
Port Authority**

90 Moonachie Avenue

April 8, 2026 - 10:30AM

Today’s Manager’s Meeting took place as a hybrid meeting in the Teterboro Airport Manager’s Conference Room – 90 Moonachie Avenue, Teterboro and remotely via Microsoft TEAMS.

Welcome

Sherri Smith opened the meeting by welcoming everyone to the Manager’s Meeting and thanked them for attending.

Airport Management - Statistical Report

Scott Marsh provided the following statistics report for March 2026:

The airport had a total of 15,495 movements during March. We pumped 5,922,436 gallons of fuel in March. Fuel was up 12% for the month. International arrivals were up 2%. The highest day for operations occurred on Thursday, March 19th, when we had 815 movements. We had an average of 500 movements for the month.

Airport Operations Report

Micah Cowan provided an update on airport operations as summarized here:

Airport Construction Project Updates

- Taxiway Q Rehabilitation
 - Preparations for Taxiway Q Rehabilitation are underway.
 - Survey work is currently underway.
- Airfield Maintenance – Upkeep
 - Two monthly airport closures will take place to facilitate airport maintenance in the main intersection of both runways. These will take place early morning at 4:30am to 5:30AM. Operations bulletins will go out about this.
- FBO Ramp Projects
 - Work continues at Signature West, Signature South and Signature East

Airport Gridlock Events

The airport had 1 gridlock event during March, which impacted the airport on 1 day, for a total of 55 minutes, reflecting 0.12% activity for the month. Gridlock events are down.

Snow Season Update

Kevin Mesones provided an update on the 2025/2026 snow season as summarized here:

- Snow season runs to April 15th
- We had 12 snow events and 2 freezing rain events so far this season, accumulating 70.0”.
- Accumulation was well above the 10-year average this year to date.

Airport Security Update

Jakub Lengowicz provided an update on security items as summarized here:

Community Watch Audit Update – The Airport conducted 15 audits and inspected 91 items. We had 0 findings.

Operations Security Update - Operations conducted 95 ID badge sweeps and had 2 findings of non-compliant conditions which were subsequently resolved. Operations processed 185 ramp access requests.

Enhanced Security Level – Enhanced security levels remain in effect as a result the situation in the Middle East. Everyone is reminded to report any unusual activity to Airport Operations and PAPD. If you see something say something.

Airport Construction Update

Daniel Nunez, Resident Engineer's Office, provided an update on construction projects as summarized here.

Stormwater Drainage – Phase 2

- Construction Progress as of April 1, 2026:
 - A final inspection of all work was held on November 24, 2025.
 - The REO's Office is coordinating with the Contractor to complete remaining punch list work now that winter conditions have subsided. They will address issues related to the compost placed during seeding operations.
 - Work is on track for completion December 2026.

Beacon Relocation – Construction Progress as of April 1st

- The high mast pole has a tentative delivery date of April 24, 2026.
- To date all underground electrical ducts have been installed as well as new concrete foundations for platforms and beacon tower.
- The next few weeks will involve completion of the electrical ground loop at the tower foundation and the start of steel fabrication for platforms, railings and stairs.
- The installation of the beacon is on track for mid-July 2026 completion.

FIFA 2026 / SAIL 250 Update

Scott Marsh provided an update on FIFA 2026 as summarized below:

Teterboro Airport – Plans and Potential Traffic Impacts

- MetLife Stadium – 8 Match Dates
 - June 13th – 1800L (Saturday) Brazil vs Morocco
 - June 16th – 1500L (Tuesday) France vs Senegal
 - June 22nd – 2000L (Monday) Norway vs Senegal
 - June 25th – 1600L (Thursday) Ecuador vs Germany
 - June 27th – 1700L (Saturday) Panama vs England
 - June 30th – 1700L (Tuesday) Knock Out Round
 - July 5th - 1600L (Sunday) Knock Out Round
 - July 19th – 1500L (Sunday) **FINAL**

Planning meetings are taking place on a regular basis. Scott reminded FBOs to let him know of advanced traffic information in order for him to facilitate coordination. FBOs are reminded to encourage customers to make reservations with FBOs prior to arrival and to stick to those reservation times.

International Naval Review – New York City /Sail 4th 250 – July 4th

A jet fly over of the Hudson will take place on July 4th as part of events related to the 250 anniversary celebrations taking place across the country this year.

ATCT Update

Traffic has picked up and is anticipated to continue to be busy up through the Summer especially prior to and during the FIFA games in June and July. ATC is anticipating increased traffic during the games and is requesting that FBOs notify them of anticipated traffic and encourage reservations in advance during those times.

Wildlife Management Report

USDA Biologist Theresa Riotto provided an update on wildlife management as summarized here:

Terri opened her presentation with a very impressive photo of a Red tailed hawk who was banded recently at the airport.

On-Airport Observations by Guild

- Small Perching Birds – 87.74%
- Blackbirds – 6.13%
- Waterfowl & Waterbirds – 2.3%
- Gulls – 0.77%

Resighting of banded red-tailed hawk

- This red-tailed hawk was originally banded at TEB on October 24, 2025 and related to western NJ.
- He was resighted in Central Park on November 2025 and again in January 2026.
- He was signed again near the East River on February 2026.

- The forum is geared towards direct public participation and two-way communication with the airport.

 - In-Depth presentation on TEB Airport Operations and noise topics including roles and responsibilities, flight procedures and runway use.
 - An expanded open discussion session where residents provided comments, voiced concerns and asked questions.
